MOËT & CHANDON BRUT IMPÉRIAL, CHAMPAGNE, PDO, NV, FRANCE



One of the world's most-loved champagne Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial is a true embodiment of the House's unique style. The wine is known for its bright fruitiness and elegant maturity. The minerally undertow imparts a subtle, smoky note that blends in with flavours of dried pineapple, biscuit, saltmond, and white peach. The palate is seductive, richly flavourful, and smooth, with fine bead and well-honed acidity.

CRISP & AROMATIC WHITES

White wines in Europe are rich in flavour that come in authentic varieties. Made with love and wine-making techniques that span generations, European white wines have a great minerality and aromatic profile.

LOIMER, GRÜNER VELTLINER, KAMPTAL, PDO, 2020, AUSTRIA (ORGANIC)

This vibrant wine features a rich, minerally core, with slightly creamy flavours of white plum and Gala apple. Pale yellow green in colour, it has a refreshing herbal aroma with scents of marigolds, clover blossoms, yellow apple, pineapple, a hint of white pepper and a well-defined finish. The crisp palate has a vein of racy acidity that complements the herbal character of the wine, a characteristic of the Grüner Veltliner grape.

KESSELSTATT, RK RIESLING, MOSEL, PDO, 2018, GERMANY

Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt is a lovely Riesling which draws one in with a charming and flattering residual sweetness and underlines the fruit intensively. A light-bodied, lemon-coloured lively wine with high acidity and high sweetness, it has peach flavours and hints of cream, underscored by citrusy acidity.

A light bodied rosé Selección de Familia Rosado has a clean and bright rose petal colour with gourmand aromas of sweet berries notes and floral touch. The palate is nice and fresh with good acidity and medium finish. This wine is paired best with grilled meat and mushrooms.

EARTHY REDS

European red wines are iconic and known worldwide. Every country in the European Union boasts of hundreds of different varieties of its own traditional wines: an astonishing parade of flavours, aromas, and finish.

CAVINO NAOUSSA, XINOMAVRO, NAOUSSA, PDO, 2017, GREECE



Made with hand-picked authentic Xinomavro grapes from the Macedonia region in Greece, this dry red has a deep ruby red colour with a rich nature bouquet of spices and red berries on the nose. Malolactic fermentation and oak ageing give this wine a rich aroma of spice and toastiness which complement the fruit-forward nature. It is a well-balanced wine with medium acidity and medium-plus tannins. With its fruity aftertaste, this wine is best enjoyed with pasta, grilled dishes or with hard cheeses.

BRANCAIA CHIANTI CLASSICO DOCG, TUSCANY, PDO, 2019, ITALY

Chianti Classico is a tribute to the terroir. This single-variety wine fascinates with its easiness and the ripe cherry notes, one of the typical aromas for Sangiovese. In the mouth, a lovely freshness and sapidity combine with young and crisp tannins.

FINE FORTIFIED WINES

Fortified wines are prepared by adding a distilled spirit, usually brandy. Over some centuries, winemakers have developed many different styles of preparing fortified wine by including port, sherry, madeira, Marsala, Commandaria wine, and the aromatised wine vermouth.



MADEIRA FINE RICH FORTIFIED WINE, MADEIRA, PDO, PORTUGAL

The Fine Rich Madeira is prepared by maturing it in casks for more than 3 years, with deep amber color, elegant aroma, ripe on the nose with hints of spices, coffee, and caramel with notes of deliberate oxidation. The wine has a palate that is rich, sweet, with ripe & cooked plum, walnut, caramel, and high acidity along with round texture with appealing and attractive after taste, which makes it a perfect dessert and a splendid after-dinner drink.

ABOUT EU

EU quality policy aims to protect the names of specific products to promote their unique characteristics, which are linked to their geographical origin and traditional know-how. Product names can be granted with a "geographical indication" (GI) if they have a specific link. This enables consumers to trust and distinguish quality products while also helping producers to market their products better.



PGI emphasises the relationship between the specific geographic region and the name of the product, where a particular quality, reputation or other characteristic is essentially attributable to its geographical origin.

Specifications

For most products, at least one of the stages of production, processing or preparation takes place in the region. In the case of wine, this means that at least 85% of the grapes used come exclusively from the geographical area where the wine is actually made.



Product names registered as PDO are those that have the strongest links to the place in which they are made.

Specifications

Every part of the production, processing and preparation process must take place in the specific region. For wines, this means that the grapes have to come exclusively from the geographical area where the wine is made.
